Excellence in Education, Classroom and Teacher Focused Grants:


- The Foundation awarded \$26.7K in Excellence in Education grants to nine separate schools with Billy Lane Lauffer and Challenger Middle Schools taking the prize for most applications submitted. The awards covered a wide variety of focus areas:
 - Academics
 - Academic, Special Education
 - Extra-Curricular Activities
 - Literacy
 - Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics

Back to Basics Program Success:

Back to Basics Emergency/Flexible Funding Program:

- Children in the Sunnyside district are often at a disadvantage as even the most basic resources are sometimes unavailable.
- One of our most successful programs is Back to Basics that provide small (\$250 maximum) grants for critical needs falling outside district or family budgets.
- We were able to award funding for shoes, socks, pull-ups, diabetic snacks for nurses to distribute, eye exams, business suits for Academic Decathlon competitions, caps and gowns for graduation ceremonies, and much more! Below is a quote from a nurse at Ocotillo Early Learning Center:

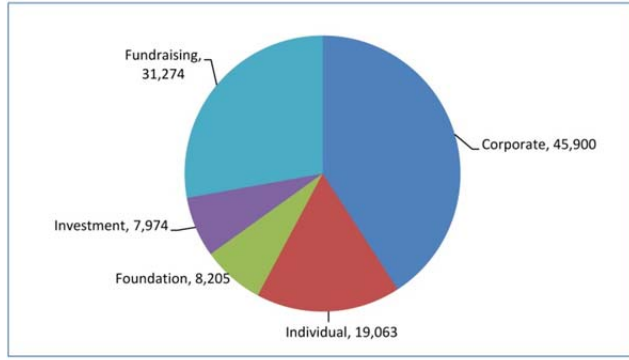
Sunnyside Foundation Excellence in Education Grants 2013

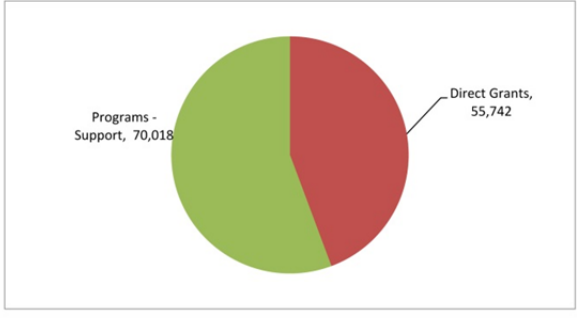

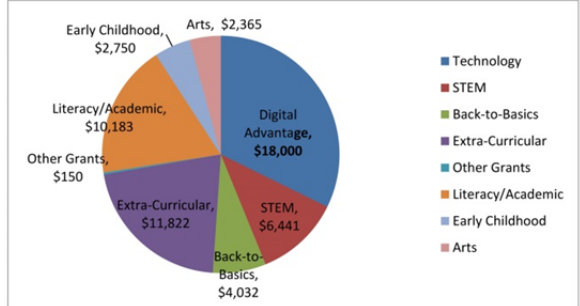
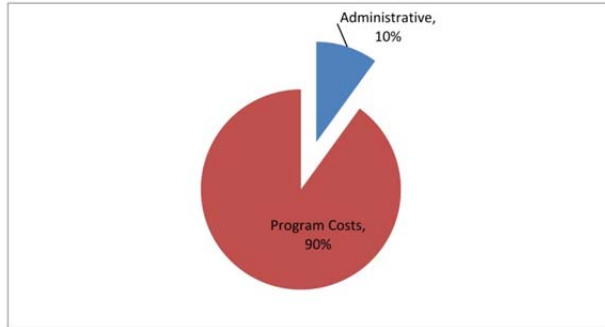
