Sunnyside Foundation Excellence in Education Grants 2012:

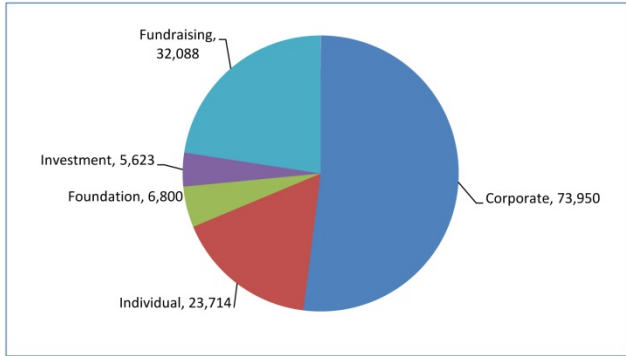

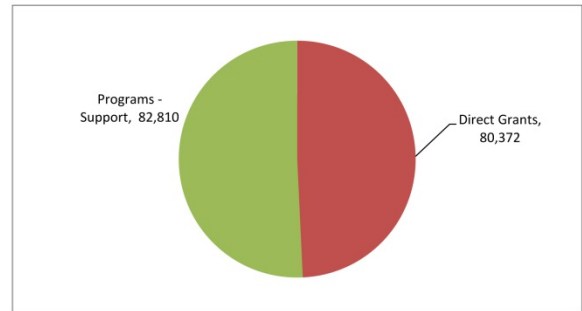

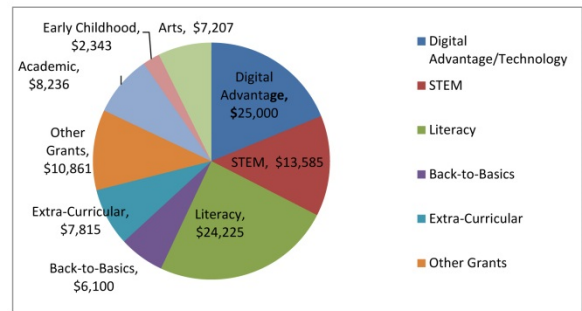
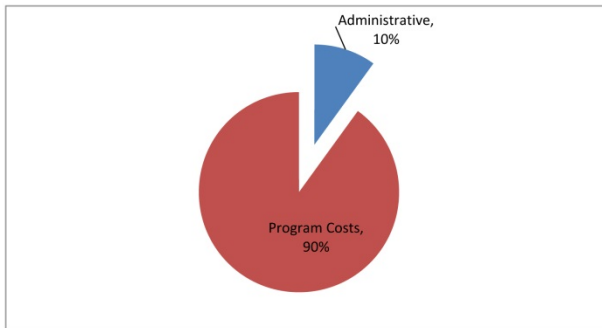
